



Where Do Arc Faults Occur?




During Construction.


During new construction or remodeling a wire can be pinched or punctured by a nail...or stapled too tightly against a wood stud.



Loose Connections. A wall plug or switch can cause an electrical fault if not properly installed, or if the connections have become loose.



Behind the Walls. The nail from a picture hanger or flooring can actually puncture insulation and cause arcing.



Damaged Cords. Insulation can be damaged when furniture is pushed up against a cord or it becomes caught and pinched in a door.

Other Possible Arcing Faults:



Damaged wires.



Worn electrical insulation.



Cables improperly nailed or stapled.



Cords in contact with vibrating metal.



Cord deteriorated by heat.



Cracked or stressed electrical cords.



Misapplied or damaged appliances.
